AYSO Region 969, a non-profit, volunteer organization, provides a youth soccer program to approximately 650 players, ranging from ages 4 to 18, every year in the Del City, Midwest City, and Tinker Air Force Base community.

All funds earned through registration and fundraisers help to purchase soccer team uniforms and equipment, to slowly continue development of a new soccer complex, and to further enhance a growing soccer organization that always places "kids first." However, not all funds raised offset the costs to develop our soccer complex to the expectations of our community in the timeframe we desire.

Enclosed is an aerial view of the AYSO Region 969 soccer complex, located off Reno Avenue in Del City. We need sand to spread out over the fields to get a good base for our playing fields. Level playing fields provide a safe playing environment for our players. The sand will also help with drainage of water off the fields and promote the growth of grass.

We would like to obtain 1,500 tons of sand from your company. We are asking you to consider donating what we need or supplying it to us at a reduced cost. We plan to work at the complex the end of this week or the first of next week. We do have a volunteer that will transport the sand to our complex at the cost of the fuel.
